A Note from Nurse Sherrie



Cold, flu, and allergy season is here in full force and symptoms are hard to distinguish from COVID symptoms. If your child has chronic allergies, it is helpful to have a note from your doctor indicating so. Please refer to the DOH guidelines when your child is returning to school after an illness:

A COVID test is required before your child returns to school if they meet the criteria in the above decision tree. Guidelines have changed and we can now accept any kind of test, including home tests. Please send test results to the school nurse at sbowers@nsd.org.

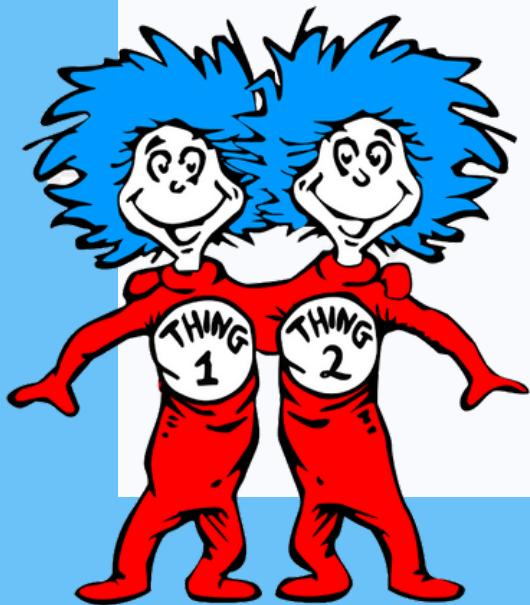

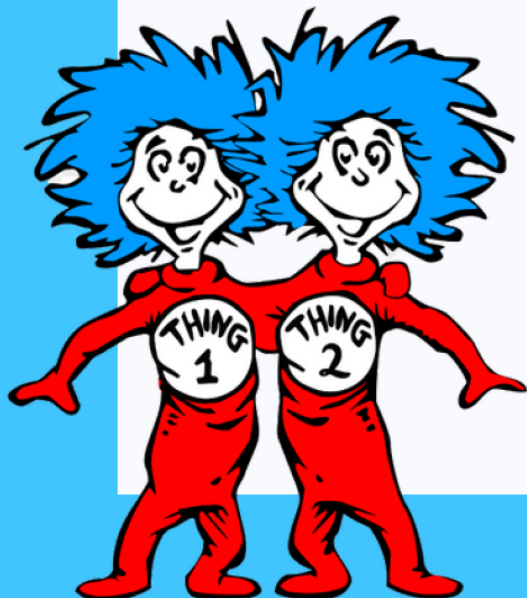
