So grateful that teachers and parents were able to connect in person and via zoom to discuss the areas of strength and growth for our students. Please keep the communication line open and active throughout the year. Our staff want to hear from you.

As we begin the holiday season, I would also like to take a moment to celebrate other accomplishments. We have a lot to be thankful for. For example:

1. With the changes to this year's 30-min. recesses (i.e. one grade at a time, and thus smaller groups), the number of reported infractions is noticeably smaller than in past pre-Covid/in-person years. Hooray!
2. Once again, Shelton View has been recognized in 2021 as one of the top 50 elementary schools in the Puget Sound Region (and is one of the top 4 Northshore elementary schools). This is based on findings and acknowledgment by the Puget Sound Business Journal.
3. Washington Achievement Awards: For those who are relatively new to Shelton View, we have recently hung up our WA State Achievement Award banners. Note that Shelton View is the only school in NSD that has received these awards for six consecutive years, for continued student academic achievement in multiple areas (ex. Overall School Academic Achievement, Growth in Math, Growth in English & Language Arts...). The State has yet to test students post-Covid.

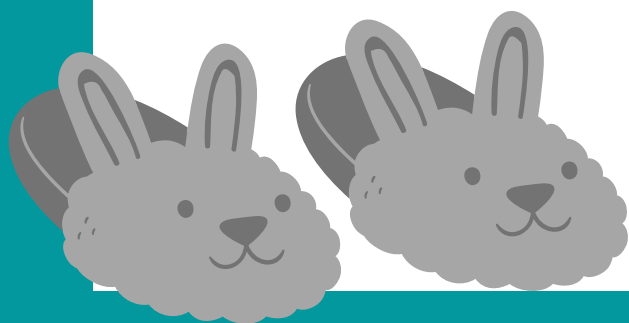
